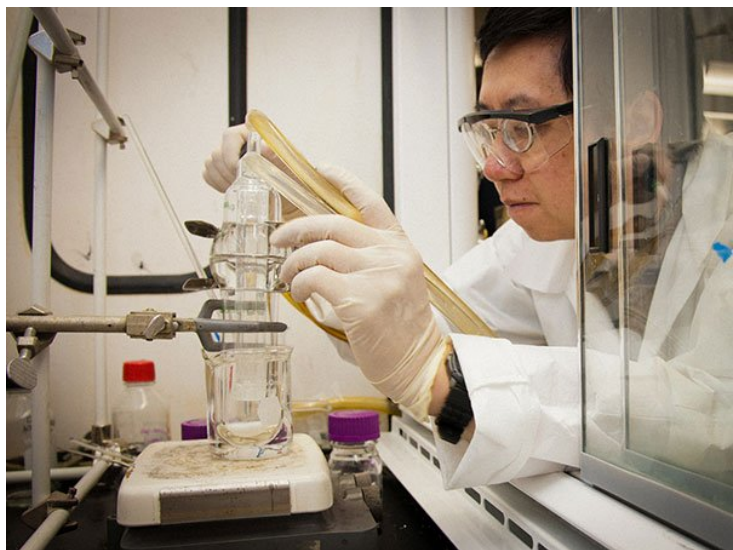


Bristol-Myers teams up with Harvard researchers in fibrotic diseases
