Myongji Hospital in South Korea has recently partnered with a technology company for blockchain-based medical services.

The technology company, BICube is recognized as a machine-learning platform. Together, the parties will manage a healthcare information exchange system to build a hybrid cloud that combines a public cloud and a private cloud.
