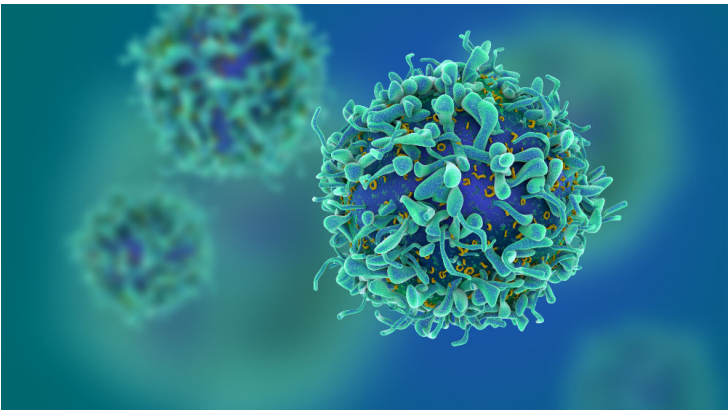


Japan's Takeda buys Adaptate Biotherapeutics to strengthen immuno-oncology portfolio

To develop novel gamma delta (??) T cell engager therapies targeting solid tumours



Takeda Pharmaceutical Company has announced the exercise of its option to acquire Adaptate Biotherapeutics, a UK-based company focused on developing antibody-based therapeutics for the modulation of variable delta 1 (V δ 1) gamma delta (??) T cells.

Through the acquisition, Japanese firm Takeda will obtain Adaptate's antibody-based ?? T cell engager platform, including pre-clinical candidate and discovery pipeline programs. Adaptate's ?? T cell engagers are designed to specifically modulate ?? T cell-mediated immune responses at tumour sites while sparing damage to healthy cells.

The planned acquisition of Adaptate follows Takeda's recently exercised option to acquire GammaDelta Therapeutics and is intended to further accelerate the development of innovative ?? T cell-based therapies.
