South Korea-based Medit, a leading provider of 3D intraoral scanners and digital dentistry solutions, has announced the release of its new app, the Medit Occlusion Analyser. It is a powerful tool that allows dental professionals to perform occlusion analysis guickly and easily without the need to return to the Medit Scan for Clinics or reprocess data.

With the app's automatic detection and analysis of occlusal interferences, users can explore the occlusal relationship and review results through annotations and colour maps.

The app's section view feature enables users to create section planes to examine specific areas of interest and use multiview to compare sections of multiple planes. Additionally, the app allows users to measure distances by one or two points for greater accuracy.

The Medit Occlusion Analyser also includes a colour map, available in both opened and closed states, to provide a visual representation of the occlusal relationship.

With alignment and edit modes, users can realign jaw data to occlusal bite based on selected areas or points and edit data by trimming, sculpting, or filling holes. The app also allows users to replay mandibular movement recordings.
