

CPHI South East Asia 2023 unveiled to empower Thailand's Pharmaceutical Industry

The regional exhibition on pharmaceutical technologies, solutions, and packaging will be held from 12-14 July 2023



Thailand will gather leading pharmaceutical and packaging producers during the upcoming CPHI South East Asia 2023 event to unlock Thailand's pharmaceutical capability and stabilize the country's pharmaceutical industry.

On **12-14 July 2023**, Informa Markets will hold a regional exhibition on pharmaceutical technologies, solutions, and packaging in the **Queen Sirikit Convention Center**, **Halls 1-3**, **G Floor**. Under the theme "At the Heart of Pharma," the forum will host around 390 pharmaceutical companies, and is an ideal platform to discover latest pharmaceutical products, technologies, and innovations, packaging as well as to exchange current knowledge and build strong networks.
