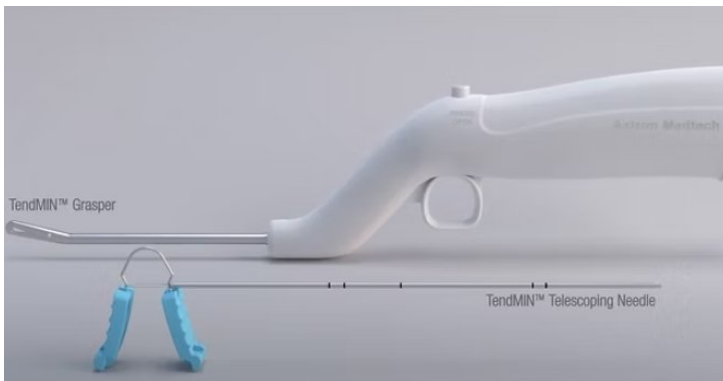


Taiwan's Astron Medtech receives Presidential Award, accelerates US commercial expansion
