


Teva gets FDA nod for generics of Eli Lilly's Evista

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Singapore: Teva Pharmaceutical has received USFDA approval of the generic equivalent to Evista (Raloxifene) Tablets, 60 mg, in the United States. Teva was first to file, making the product eligible for 180 days of marketing exclusivity.

Evista 60 mg Tablets marketed by Eli Lilly and Company, had annual sales of approximately USD824 million in the United States, according to IMS data as of December 2013.
